

1.2. How to Test your Payment System.

Once you have set up your Stripe account and it's been linked to your website, you can do a test, to make sure the system is working.

Here's a step-by-step guide.

Go to your Website and use it as a customer would. (Purchase an item)

1. Add items to your Basket and go to Checkout

Fill in the Billing details. This can be you own address or a made up address.
